Brief Project Description: Enerdu Power Systems (or “Enerdu”, the proponent) is proposing the expansion and redevelopment of its existing hydroelectric facility, the Enerdu Generation Station (GS). The proposed project would involve the construction of an expanded powerhouse and the redevelopment of the weir to increase the present generation capacity from 0.3 MW to approximately 0.95 MW. No changes to water levels from currently established practices are proposed either upstream or downstream of the site.	
Summary of Conclusions of Environmental Report: Numerous management strategies for mitigating potential negative impacts associated with the proposed development, and a list of commitments to be implemented throughout the project life cycle are outlined in the Environmental Report. It was determined that with the implementation of the proposed management measures, the proposed expansion and redevelopment of the Enerdu GS would not result in significant adverse effects on the biophysical, socioeconomic and cultural environment.	
Summary of Aboriginal Engagement and Outcome: The project site lies within the traditional territory of the Algonquins of Ontario (AOO). Information on the project was provided to the AOO throughout the EA planning process and a meeting was held between the AOO and the proponent after the release of the final Environmental Report. In a March 28, 2013 letter to the AOO, Enerdu outlined various commitments to continue working collaboratively with the AOO in developing and implementing eel passage strategies and maintaining ongoing dialogue with the AOO during construction and excavation activities. In an April 8, 2013 letter, the AOO indicated that they do not object to the expansion and redevelopment of the Enerdu GS.	
Summary of Public and Agency Consultation and Outcome: The Notice of Commencement, advertisements in support of public meetings and the Notice of Completion were advertised in local media and distributed to the project contact list electronically and by post. Public meetings were held on September 26, 2011 and February 7, 2012; the proponent attended a community-organized public meeting on April 11, 2012 to discuss the project. Throughout the course of the EA, revisions to the project design were made based on feedback from the public and regulatory bodies. A draft report was issued to regulators on January 10, 2012. The Final Environmental Report was made available for public review and comment from December 17, 2012 to February 1, 2013 (47 days).



Sixteen Part II Order (PIIO) Requests for an individual EA were received during the Notice of Completion review period. Throughout late January to mid-March, 2013, responses to each PIIO request were prepared by the EA team and sent to each requester. All issues and concerns raised in the Part II Order requests were compiled into a table along with the proponent’s response to each issue/concern, and submitted to the Environmental Approvals Branch of the Ministry of the Environment on March 18, 2013. In a letter dated November 18, 2013, the Minister of the Environment confirmed that an Individual EA was not required. As conditions of the Minister's decision, the proponent must arrange for a Heritage Impact Assessment and additional hydraulic modeling to be conducted prior to any construction activities.
