Brief Project Description
To commence operation of an existing 0.035 megawatt waterpower generating station.
Summary of Conclusions of Environmental Report
The conclusions of the report indicate this micro-scale waterpower system has a low degree of environmental alteration consistent with what one would expect from a micro run-of-river project on a small weir utilizing existing infrastructure.
Summary of Aboriginal Engagement and Outcome:
Three Aboriginal communities were identified and contacted - one indicated it has no questions or concerns with respect to the project, one indicated it is not currently concerned with the micro hydro project and no questions or concerns were identified by the third.
Summary of Public and Agency Consultation and Outcome:
PUBLIC:
Consultation and involvement of the public was completed by notifying the public about the project, obtaining feedback, information, comments and concerns about the project, incorporating that information into the ESR and addressing public concerns. The primary method used was a public notification by way of a newspaper ad setting out the Notice of Commencement and Notice of Public Information Meeting and the holding of the meeting on September 24, 2016. Additionally, copies of the notices were distributed to persons residing around the property upon which the existing weir is located. There were no issues.
AGENCIES:
Relevant federal and provincial legislation as identified in OWA's Class Environmental Assessment for Waterpower Projects was reviewed and addressed and the following provincial agencies were consulted – the MOECC, the MNRF and the MTCS. The local CA was also consulted. A summary of the results of the consultation are set out below.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The hands off flow was changed from 220 liters per second to 350 liters per second - All of the hands off flow will now pass through the existing outlet in the base of the weir in order to pass cooler water downstream. The target water level on the pond will therefore be set equal to the top of the weir crest such that there is no flow over the weir. - Based on an on-site meeting with Hydro One on April 27th, 2017, it appears it's possible and likely that the electrical connection will change and instead use the existing poles along old Hwy 6 (which is in the process of being abandoned) which would result in electrical connection coming by pole down old Hwy 6, over the abandoned bridge and in from the road to the pole by the mill building.


